Welcome Yarrow Water Users as we are celebrating our 80th anniversary this year. We were incorporated by Letters Patent by the Provincial Government on

March 23, 1944. 80 years of own community water system, quite impressive in today's world.

As weather predictions are forecasting another hot, dry summer, we need to remind ourselves about water conservation. With reports of a 63% normal South Coast snowpack & 66 % province wide, the Provincial Government is raising awareness about possible severe drought conditions again for 2024. Both Chilliwack, Abbotsford & most of the communities province wide have started water restrictions on May 1, one month ahead of their regular

June 1 date. Current Stage 1 water restrictions limit lawn & garden watering to 2 days / week depending on house address, from either 5-8 am or 7-10 pm. Even addresses Wednesday & Saturday and odd addresses Thursday & Sunday. All other water use must have a spring-loaded shutoff nozzle on your hose. YWD follows Chilliwack's lead with water restrictions to help conserve our precious resource although locally we have had no current supply issues. With the community support, we don't have to use much of our resources enforcing the restrictions. If we had water supply issues, we'd notify everyone quickly to ensure water is available for fire protection and public use. Before 1944 & the creation of YWD, the 176 properties were serviced by wells. Please remember some of these properties

still have wells, a few others have installed wells since then, all within YWD & their green lawns may not use YWD supplied water for irrigation.


